WINDFORCE 2014 Federal Minister for Economic Affairs and Energy, Sigmar Gabriel, becomes patron



Good news from Berlin: Sigmar Gabriel is the patron of WINDFORCE 2014. The managing director of WINDFORCE 2014, Jens Eckhoff, is pleased that once again a German minister has committed himself to taking on patronage of the trade fair and conference following on from previous patrons Philipp Rösler and Peter Altmaier. "Despite what is being said at the moment, we see it as a positive sign that Mr Gabriel is involved with WINDFORCE", commented Jens Eckhoff on the situation. After it emerged that changes were made to the tariffs for offshore wind power that were contrary to the coalition agreement just signed in November, both Jens Eckhoff and Ronny Meyer, managing director of WAB, took part in talks in Berlin with the German minister.

It was no easy task to put together the conference programme for WINDFORCE 2014 from the large number of abstracts submitted. The programme includes theme sessions on cost reduction, safety, and grid connection, as well as an overview of the German market and current developments in the United States, Great Britain and France. This year the conference programme is being extended by two breakfast sessions starting at 8 a.m. on both days of the conference. On Wednesday, 18 June, offshore turbines are on the agenda, and one day later, floating foundations come under the spotlight. Tailwind for the Baltic Sea countries: WINDFORCE Baltic Sea – an information platform on development in countries bordering the Baltic

What is the situation regarding offshore wind energy in Finland? Does Poland's energy policy have a place for renewable energies? What experiences do Sweden and Denmark have to share as the Baltic Sea's leading nations in terms of installing and operating offshore wind farms? Some 120 participants found answers to these and a number of other questions at WINDFORCE Baltic Sea. The second WINDFORCE Baltic Sea conference took place from 5 to 6 February 2014. International participants saw the particular value of the event in the opportunity it offered to gain an overview of the current situation and policy discussions on offshore wind energy in seven countries. Representatives of associations in Estonia, Lithuania, Finland, Sweden, Denmark, Germany and Poland informed others about the state of affairs in their countries and were available for talks with participants. Bremen's senator for economic affairs, Martin Günthner (SPD), also took the opportunity to personally welcome international participants to the conference and to gain insight into ongoing discussions in other countries.
